WEATHERIZATION GRANT AWARDED TO THREE RIVERS

Three Rivers was recently awarded \$6,000 to assist in outdoor weather strategies to help small businesses successfully navigate the winter ahead and prevent the spread of COVID-19, the Small Business Association of Michigan partnered with the Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity (LEO) to administer at least \$3 million in weatherization grants to assist qualified small businesses with expanding outdoor capacity during the cold weather months.

Three Rivers will use the grant funds to purchase multiple outdoor heaters and outdoor furniture to create COVID safe space over the coming months.
