

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Bidding Information

Performance Bids

The City of Three Rivers is committed to the concept of performance bids. All vendors are encouraged to submit bids which conform to the stated specifications, as well as, suggest deviations from the specifications, which in the vendor's opinion would be beneficial to the City in terms of price and performance. The City reserves the right to accept or reject any bid under these terms.

I. Instructions

- A. Bids must be typewritten or clearly printed in ink and signed by a duly-authorized representative of the firm submitting the quote.
- B. Bids must be submitted in sealed envelopes, clearly marked on the outside, "**Bids for FY 2019 Pavement Marking**".
- C. Bids will be received by the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 333 West Michigan Avenue, Three Rivers, Michigan, 49093, until **2:00 p.m. local time, Thursday, August 9, 2018**. All bids will be date stamped and time marked when received.
- D. Faxed or emailed bids shall not be accepted.
- E. If you received this document from our website, please e-mail your contact information to aroth@threeriversmi.org so we can place you on the bidders list for addenda.

II. Conditions Applicable to Bids

- A. Applicable Laws: The Ordinances and Charter of the City, and laws of the State of Michigan concerning competitive bidding, contracts and purchases will be employed.
- B. Taxes: The City of Three Rivers is generally exempt from Federal Excise and Michigan State Sales Tax. Prices should not include tax.
- C. If the bidder elects to deviate from the specifications stated, all exceptions or other changes must be clearly noted.
- D. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive informalities or defects in bids, or accept such bids as it shall deem to be in the best interest of the City of Three Rivers.
- E. The City does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, age or disability in employment or the provision of services.
- F. The City has a local preference policy, which is available upon request.
- G. The Contractor shall provide proof of Liability and Workman's Compensation Insurance and a completed W-9 form prior to award of the contract.
- H. The successful bidder shall provide the City with a copy of this liability insurance policy in the amount of \$2,000,000 (Two million Dollars) which names the City of Three Rivers as second insured.
- I. Anticipated award is at the **August 21, 2018** Commission meeting. Final completion of this project shall be no later than **October 31, 2018**.

III. Specifications for Pavement Marking

PART 1 GENERAL

1.01 SCOPE

- A. This Section includes preparation of the pavement for new pavement markings, and other work and materials incidental to the markings.

1.02 SUBMITTALS

- A. Submittals shall include:
 - 1. Information for the Record:
 - a. Detailed product information on paint

PART 2 PRODUCTS

2.01 Waterborne Paint

- A. As specified in the general section of this bid document.

PART 3 EXECUTION

3.01 MARKING REMOVAL

- A. All existing markings in poor condition and requiring removal shall be removed prior to new marking installation

3.02 MARKING INSTALLATION

- A. Weather and Time Limitations - Waterborne paint shall be applied when the surface temperature of the pavement is 50 Degrees F. or higher and the pavement is dry. The Contractor shall be responsible for making the decision to apply waterborne paint on a specific day when there is a high probability of rain in the forecast. If applied lines are washed away because of rain the Contractor shall be responsible for re-applying the lines at no additional expense to the City.
- B. Waterborne Pavement Marking materials can be placed immediately on new bituminous pavement. Waterborne pavement marking material shall not be placed before May 1st or after October 31st. These limitations may be waived at the discretion of the Engineer
- C. Protection of Lines The protection of the wet paint shall be the responsibility of the Contractor. Cost of protecting the wet paint shall be included in the pay items listed in the Proposal.
- D. All layout work necessary for the location and placing of centerline, edge lines and lane lines shall be the responsibility of the Contractor and will not be paid for separately.
- E. Pavement Markings which are improperly located shall be corrected by the Contractor. Improperly located markings shall be removed at the Contractor's expense; in a manner acceptable to the City and reapplied in the correct locations at the Contractor's expense. Applied pavement markings with defects such as, but not limited to, fuzzy edges, non-uniform thickness, improper width, or non-uniform retro reflective features,

or an adhesion failure with the pavement surface, shall be considered unacceptable and replaced at the Contractor's expense.

- F. It is planned that the City of Three Rivers will be conducting roadway mill and fill activities during this same time period on roadways included in the pavement marking bid. New markings shall not be applied until that work has been completed. Roadways include:
 - A. Railroad Drive

PART 4 SPECIAL PROVISIONS

4.01 PAVEMENT MARKING DETAILS

- A. Hoffman Street – US 131 to M-60
 - 1. Cold Pour Plastic Removals include Stop bars, "ONLY" symbols, Arrows and RR Symbols. All removals are between US 131 and N Main (BR 131).

- B. Armitage St @ N Main
 - 1. No removals required at this intersection

- C. Enterprise Drive – BR 131 (N Main) to Lovers Lane
 - 1. All stop bars, left and right turn arrows remain
 - 2. Removals include Cold Pour Plastic "Only"

- D. Railroad Drive – W Michigan Ave to Prutzman
 - A. No removals required
 - B. Roadway is scheduled for a mill and fill prior to new pavement marking

- E. Parking lot along Railroad Drive near W Michigan Ave
 - A. No removals required

- F. Pealer St (Moore) – Benjamin to N Main
 - A. No removals required
