Dear Three Rivers Residents,

As winter recedes and snow melts away, we want to make you aware that conditions we commonly refer to as “blight” can become more visible, things like accumulated trash or yard waste, discarded furniture, and inoperable or unregistered vehicles stored outdoors. Keeping properties in good repair protects neighborhood safety, home values, and community pride. To support that goal, the Police Department and Code Enforcement will conduct routine seasonal patrols and respond to complaints in accordance with City ordinances. When we identify concerns, our first step is to provide notice of the issue, outline what needs to be corrected, and allow ten days for compliance before considering citations.

We’re asking for your partnership. Please take a moment to assess your property as the weather warms and address any items that may have surfaced over the winter months. If you need guidance on what qualifies as a violation or how to remedy one, contact the Three Rivers Police Department’s Code Enforcement for assistance at 269.467.4195. You can also report potential blight concerns on the city’s website, so we can follow up and help maintain safe, clean neighborhoods for everyone. Thank you for doing your part to keep Three Rivers as a community, an amazing place to live.

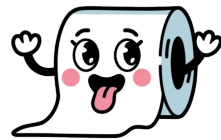

What Not to Flush: Protecting Our Wastewater System

The Three Rivers wastewater treatment plant works hard every day to treat our wastewater and protect our community—but it needs your help! Many common household items cause clogs, equipment damage, and costly repairs when flushed down the toilet.



Only flush the 3 P's:

- Pee
- Poop
- (Toilet) Paper

Please do NOT flush:

- “Flushable” wipes (baby, cleaning, or personal wipes)
- Paper towels or napkins
- Feminine hygiene products
- Diapers
- Cotton balls, swabs, or dental floss
- Grease, fats or oils
- Medications
- Cat Litter

K9 Officer Bowen partnered with K9 Goose in September 2025, kicking off an exciting new chapter for the department's K9 Unit. The duo successfully completed an intensive 240-hour K9 Academy, graduating on December 5, 2025. During training, they earned both their IPWDA Patrol Certification and Narcotics Detection Certification — officially making them street-ready.
