**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT AN ELECTION WILL BE HELD ON TUESDAY, AUGUST 7, 2018. THE POLLS WILL BE OPEN FROM 7:00 A.M. TO 8:00 P.M.**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that candidates of the following partisan offices are to be voted for in St. Joseph County: US Senator, US Representative in Congress, State Representative, County Commissioner, and such other partisan offices that may by law be required to be nominated at the primary.

**PLEASE BE FURTHER NOTIFIED** that delegates to the Republican Party and Democratic Party county conventions will be elected at the August 7, 2018 Primary Election.

**THE FURTHER PURPOSE** of the election is to vote on the following proposals as presented and listed below:

**COUNTY PROPOSAL(S)**

TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY MILLAGE RENEWAL AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY TO LEVY .33 OF A MILL (\$0.33 PER \$1,000 OF TAXABLE VALUATION) FOR A PERIOD OF FOUR (4) YEARS FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF OPERATION MILLAGE FOR THE St. JOSEPH COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR THE CONTINUATION OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES.

**ABSENTEE BALLOTS** are available for all elections; registered voters may contact the local clerk to obtain an application for an absent voter ballot. You may vote by absentee ballot if you:

- Are unable to attend the polls without assistance;
- Are 60 years of age or older;
- Expect to be absent from your city or township for the entire time the polls are open on election day;
- Are in jail, awaiting arraignment or trial;
- Have been assigned to work as a precinct inspector in a precinct other than where you are registered; or
- Are unable to attend the polls because of religious beliefs.
