**City of Three Rivers  
River Drive Reconstruction**

The City of Three Rivers is requesting Bids for the construction of the River Drive Reconstruction project. Bids for the construction of the Project will be received by the City of Three Rivers, 333 W. Michigan Ave., Three Rivers, MI 49093 until **2:00 p.m.** local time, **Thursday, August 25, 2022**. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The project includes the resurfacing of approximately 1,730' of road with HMA and HMA millings including construction of an 850' long, 14'-wide one-way segment with HMA millings surface, HMA millings base, and a parking bumpout; concrete curb and gutter, surface restoration, and tree planting along the riverbank. The project also includes 4,000' of sanitary sewer CIPP and manhole lining, sanitary lateral cleanout and reinstatement, bypass pumping, and all related work.

Bids will be accepted only from Plan Holders of Record. In order to be a Plan Holder of Record Bidding Documents must be obtained from the Issuing Office.

Bidding Documents will be emailed in portable document format (PDF) at no charge.

The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents.

A pre-bid conference will not be held.

For all further requirements regarding bid submittal, qualifications, procedures, and contract award, refer to the Instructions to Bidders that are included in the Bidding Documents.

The City of Three Rivers reserves the right to accept any bid, reject any or all bids, to waive informalities and make the award in any manner deemed in the best interest of the City of Three Rivers.
