

Spring CLEAN UP

Clean out those cupboards! Get rid of that garage clutter! Beautify those basements! The time for spring cleaning has arrived! The week of April 23, 2018, the City of Three Rivers will be partnering with Waste Management to provide a one-time removal of items for residential properties. Items will be picked up by district as follows:

- 1st District: Monday, April 23rd**
- 2nd District: Tuesday, April 24th**
- 3rd District: Wednesday, April 25th**
- 4th District: Thursday, April 26th**

Items to be picked up should be placed on the terrace area of yard along with regular trash. Please note, if Waste Management is not your trash removal provider, your regular trash may be picked up at a different time.

***This event does not include residents in the downtown area. The downtown area will be provided dumpsters starting April 23rd.

SAVE THE DATE! The city's annual Community Clean-up Day will be on Saturday, May 19th this year. This event will focus on the clean-up of our parks and other public areas with projects like trash pick-up and flower planting among others. More information to come.

The following restrictions apply to all disposed materials:

1. Refuse must be neatly placed curbside in an orderly fashion.
2. No refrigerators, freezers, or air conditioners will be accepted; unless certification sticker is placed on item indicating that the freon has been removed.
3. No household garbage will be accepted.
4. No individual item over 5' long, 3' wide, or 3' high, weighing over 100 lbs will be accepted.
5. No automotive/marine batteries will be accepted.
6. No tires or rims will be accepted.
7. No materials that are prohibited from disposal in TYPE II landfills (paints, solvents, oils, etc.) will be accepted. (Note: Paint cans that are open and contain only DRY paint will be accepted.)
8. No propane cylinders will be accepted.
9. All construction / demolition material must be less than one cubic yard in total volume for curbside pickup.
10. No lawnmowers or small engines will be accepted unless the gasoline has been completely drained.
11. Total curbside volume shall not exceed 3 cubic yards.
12. Windows, glass, and mirrors must be less than 3' x 4' in size.
